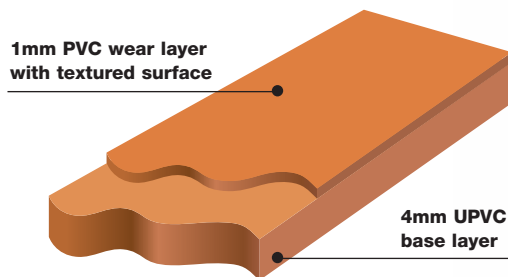

Aikona flooring has a tough textured surface that offers good slip resistance. It is guaranteed for 10 years for normal foot traffic when installed and maintained in accordance with the recommendations contained in Aikona's data sheet on Installation and Maintenance.

Aikona is available in various sizes, either plain planks or with a nautical stripe. It can be varnished using vinyl floor sealer or water based varnish. Please see Aikona's data sheet on Installation and Maintenance for recommended treatments.
